

Wildlife Keeper for a Day at The New Forest Wildlife Park

Would you like the experience "ups and downs" of being a Wildlife Keeper?

The following general itinerary can be tailored to suit individual interests.

General Itinerary

Arrival -

- Meet your personal Wildlife Keeper - and the other members of the animal team.
You will spend the day with your personal keeper sharing all their tasks.
- Prepare the animal feeds in the Animal Feed Kitchen
- Feed and meet our tame Deer in the Owlery.
- Next morning feed for Otters and other Nightwatch Barn residents.
- Morning cleaning routine of various enclosures/pools (full day only)
- The wild boar and wallaby feed.
- Lynx feed during 'Keeper Talk" for our visitors
- Visit animal hospital with the possibility of meeting any current residents
- Time to choose, if you are passionate about a particular animal or bird, let us know and we will arrange for you to help with their daily routines such as cleaning pens, feeding or watering, making and giving them enrichment toys.
- Owl afternoon feed (full day only)
- Enjoy the Wolf encounter (full day only)

End of your visit - with any final questions and receive your gift pack.

Information:

- **Full day** - £180 (10.00am to 4.30pm) **Half day** - £150 (10.00am to 1.30pm)
- Must have good footwear/wellies /waterproof coat, hat, suncream, etc.
- **Full day keepers** - lunch with the keepers.
- **Half day visitors** - coffee or tea break with the keepers.

Gift Pack includes:

- £10 gift voucher to spend in the gift shop
- Souvenir certificate with your photograph taken on your day will be posted
- T-shirt to wear on the day and take home
- One disposable camera
- Annual adoption of your choice of animal
- All day entry on that day to the wildlife park
